2. I am applying to the Department of Justice and Attorney-General to recognise the electrical licence or registration in accordance with the mutual recognition principle under the *Mutual Recognition (Queensland) Act 1992*.
3. I am not the subject of disciplinary proceedings in any State (including any preliminary investigations or action that might lead to disciplinary proceedings) in relation to this occupation.
4. My registration in any State is not cancelled or currently suspended as a result of disciplinary action.
5. I am not otherwise personally prohibited from carrying on any such occupation in any State, and am not subject to any special conditions in carrying on that occupation, as a result of criminal, civil or disciplinary proceedings in any State.
6. I am subject to the following special conditions in the carrying out of my occupation in any State:

7. I give consent to the Department of Justice and Attorney-General to make inquiries of, and exchange information with, the authorities of any State regarding my activities in the occupation or otherwise regarding matters relevant to this declaration.
8. I have attached the original instrument or a copy of the original instrument that evidences my existing registration, and certify that it is the original or a complete and accurate copy of the original.
