The Department of Justice and Attorney-General is the government agency responsible for administering justice, industrial relations and safety services in Queensland.

The department delivers diverse services to urban, rural and remote communities throughout the state, including:

- courts and tribunals
- legal and advocacy services
- a range of community-focused programs, policies and services, including services to protect vulnerable people
- services aimed at improving productivity, equity and safety in Queensland workplaces.



Justice Services

The department administers more than 100 courts throughout Queensland and offers a wide range of services to the community.

We deliver an open and accessible justice system by:

- leading the development and reform of the state's criminal, civil and human rights laws
- providing financial assistance and support to victims of crime and their families
- mediating neighbourhood and workplace disputes
- supporting adults who have an impaired decision-making capacity and their families
- appointing justices of the peace (JPs) and improving access to their services
- collecting court fines
- registering births, deaths and marriages
- providing civil marriage ceremony services
- providing legal services and advice to the state government through Crown Law
- resourcing the office of the independent Director of Public Prosecutions to ensure people charged with serious offences are prosecuted to the full extent of the law
- deciding a wide range of disputes and reviewing decisions which affect the community and businesses.

Fair and Safe Work Queensland

The department's Office of Fair and Safe Work Queensland was established to further improve productivity and fairness at work, electrical safety in the community, and workplace health and safety.

We protect the community, workers' rights and safety of Queenslanders by:

- making sure workplaces are safe and healthy so workers return home safely every day
- making sure employers abide by state child employment, private employment agents and trading hours laws
- administering laws to keep your home electrically safe, including mandatory safety switches
- ensuring high standards of electrical safety through licensing electrical contractors and workers
- providing information services on workplace health and safety, and electrical safety for all workers and employers
- providing industrial and employee relations strategy, policy and advice to the Queensland Government as an employer to ensure cooperative and productive workplaces.

We also advocate for fair and cooperative workplaces so Queenslanders can have productive and decent work.
