

Call for expressions of interest Appointment as a Mediator under the *Retail Shop Leases Act 1994*

The Honourable Jarrod Bleijie MP, Attorney–General and Minister for Justice, seeks expressions of interest for appointment as a Mediator under the *Retail Shop Lease Act 1994*.

Mediators are responsible for seeking to resolve, by mediation, retail tenancy disputes within a mediator's jurisdiction as provided in the *Retail Shop Lease Act 1994*.

Mediators' jurisdiction

A mediator has jurisdiction to mediate retail tenancy disputes as provided for in the *Retail Shop Leases Act 1994* (section 97).

Conditions of appointment

A mediator may be appointed for a term not longer than 3 years.

A mediator who is not a member of the public service is to be paid the remuneration and allowances as decided by the Governor in Council. The current remuneration is a fee of \$110.00 per hour (GST included).

Mediators appointed, excluding those who are public servants, enter into an agreement for the supply of mediation services.

How to apply

Applicants should provide a covering letter and curriculum vitae detailing their suitability for appointment as a mediator by reference to their qualifications and experience.
