I am writing to record my objection to any proposed changes to the RTI legislation which would restrict public access to information regarding details of successful applicants to government and public service positions.

It is imperative that the Queensland people are able to have faith in the State government, and one of the principles underpinning 'a fair go' is the absence of nepotistic appointments.

Any attempt to reduce the access to information pertaining to public service appointments to preserve an individual from public scrutiny suggests that this is of greater importance than transparency of government appointments, and as such will automatically diminish the faith of the people in their State government.
